ABOUT WISDOM KEEPERS

Wisdom Keepers is a powerful new film series celebrating knowledge, storytelling, and resilience. Presented by PBS Books, the series explores the traditions and teachings of communities across America and highlights the wisdom that continues to shape our shared future.

Through this initiative, libraries, faith-based organizations, educational institutions, and community partners are invited to host local screening events and public discussions designed to foster learning, reflection, and dialogue within their communities.

TO PARTICIPATE AND SIGN UP

Libraries, community organizations, and educational partners may host free public screenings of the Wisdom Keepers films during the official screening window.

Screening Event Key Dates

Screening Event Window	January 15 – May 31, 2026
Post-Event Survey Window	January 15 – June 10, 2026

SCREENING REQUIREMENTS

Once your screener application has been submitted, screening partners agree to the following terms:

- Screenings must:
 - Be free and open to the public
 - Take place only within the designated screening window
 - Include an engagement activity such as a facilitated discussion, speaker presentation, or community reflection
 - Adhere to PBS Books' content and advocacy guidelines
- Partners must:
 - Complete the Post-Event Survey within seven (7) days of the event
 - Follow PBS Books branding and promotional use guidelines

Important Use Restrictions:

Films and videos provided by PBS Books may only be used for your approved Wisdom Keepers screening event. They may not be shared, streamed, altered, duplicated, sold, or otherwise reproduced, and must be deleted or destroyed following the conclusion of your event.

AVAILABLE RESOURCES

PBS Books will provide a comprehensive set of tools and materials to help your organization plan, promote, and host your screening event.

Resources will be available four to six weeks before the start of the screening window and include:
